Meeting Info

Board Meeting - January 19, 2012

The January 19th Board meeting began at 6:30 p.m. and ended at 7:30 p.m. There were seven Board members in attendance.

The following items were attended to at this meeting:

- ◆ Secretary's Report: The reading of the December Board minutes was suspended.
- ◆ Treasurer's Report: Evelyn Czyz reported to the group that the BCPAAA treasury now has \$3,842.53. She also mentioned that dues and initiation fees collection are under way.
- ◆ A discussion was held on BCPAAA, Class - 5 members holding elected office.
- ◆ Wendy Linderman will be sending out an e-mail on elections.
- ◆ Sue Esker announced that a May 19, 2012 Shredding Day has been scheduled with the Cintas Corporation. She was asked by the group to submit a September 22, 2012 to Cintas for a Fall Shredding Event.
- ◆ The Board voted unanimously to make a donation to Chief DeForest's Pan Ohio Hope Bike Ride fund raiser.
- ◆ Vicky Kirkpatrick will fill-out the form required by Buehler's to schedule the BCPAAA for participation in a Hot Dog Sale. Suggested dates are 6/30 and 7/28.
- ◆ Evelyn Czyz made final comments on the upcoming visit to the Medina County Jail on February 16th at 7:00 p.m.
- ◆ A discussion was held and a vote taken on approving the use of the 501c3 by the Eagles. The vote passed.

MEMBER'S MEETING - JANUARY 19, 2012

This meeting, attended by 13 members and Chief Carl DeForest began at 7:30 p.m. and ended at 8:35 p.m.

- ◆ Guest Speaker: Chief Carl DeForest was the group's guest speaker. His topic covered the charitable side of the Brunswick Division of Police. During his presentation, the chief provided background and other information on the We're MADD Bicycle Team that participates in the Pedal to the Point Ride. Other events mentioned included the Team LP (Named after former Sergeant Larry Pringle.) Relay for Life Team; the Law Enforcement Special Olympics Torch Run; and the newest venture, the Pan Ohio Hope Bike Ride to be held at the end of July. Chief DeForest stated that he will provide the dates of fundraisers for the various events to the BCPAAA as they become available.
- ◆ Secretary's Report: The reading of the minutes was suspended.
- ◆ Treasurer's Report: Treasurer, Evelyn Czyz, provide the group with information on AAA finances. The Treasury now has \$3,842.53.
- ◆ Deanna Dingess explained her volunteer duties in the Communications Department.
- ◆ Project Lifesaver: Wendy Linderman updated on current clients and talked about a soon to be held interview with a new client.
- ◆ Jail Visit: A hand-out sheet on directions and rules to be followed while at the jail was passed out. Members also signed up for this visit.
- ◆ Elections: An e-mail will be forthcoming.
- ◆ Shredding Event: It was announced that the Spring event will be held on May 19th from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.
- ◆ By-laws: Two by-laws revisions were voted on by those present. Section 2, Name and Purpose - Mission Statement and Section 4 Volunteer Coordinator, Government were amended unanimously.
- ◆ Credit Shield: Evelyn Czyz passed out special credit card holders. These holders were provided courtesy of the Sheriff's Department.
