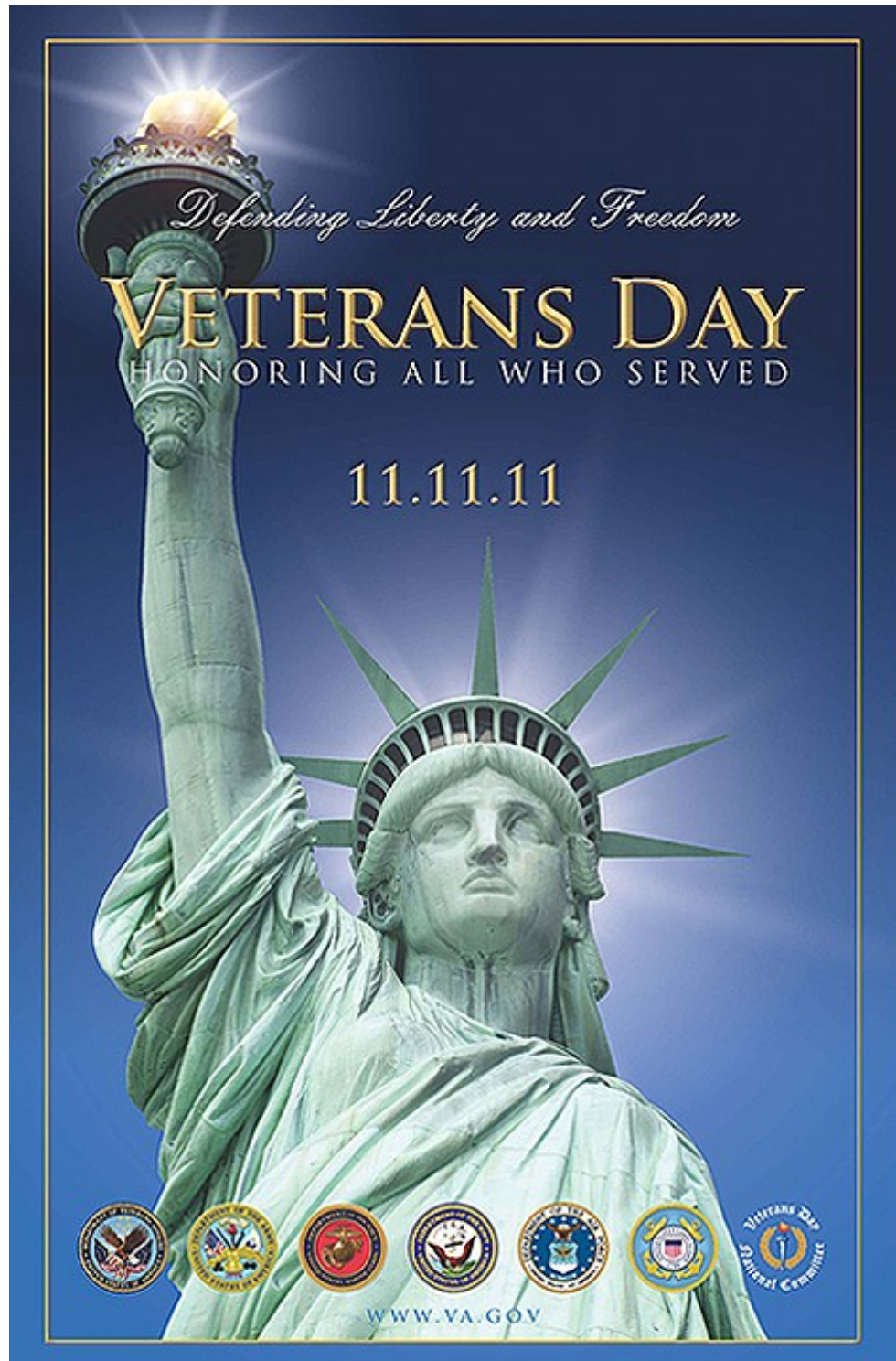

The following items were discussed during the meeting:

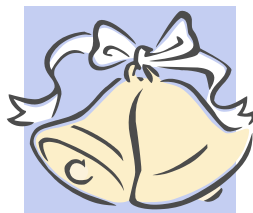
