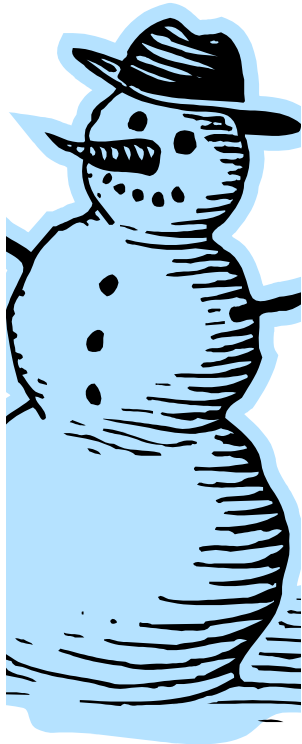

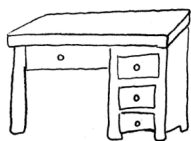
2010 in REVIEW
