APPLICATION FOR STUDENT EXEMPTION

Persuant to Section 880.04(e) 12 of the Brunswick Codified Code, you may wish to claim exemption for earnings as a student dependent living outside Brunswick while attending college. To claim this exemption, the following provisions must be met:

- 1. Student must provide copy of student ID card and proof of enrollment at college or university.
- 2. Student must provide copy of first page of Federal Return (front & back) showing they did not take exemption for themself.
- 3. If student has no Federal Return, but still has earnings, must provide their parent's Social Security Number so tax office can cross-reference to see the parents of said student have claimed student as dependent. (In this case, Parents are required to attach first page of the Federal Return (front & back) to their Brunswick City Tax return and file by due date.)
- 4. Student must provide proof of residency outside City of Brunswick while attending college or university.
- 5. Student must provide proof of residency outside City of Brunswick while earning any and all compensation.

NOTE: Compliance with either numbers 1, 2, 4 & 5 above or compliance with 1, 3, 4 & 5 above must be met for the exemption to be validly claimed under 880.04(e) 12.
