AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1442.02(a) OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY DETAILING ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION.

WHEREAS: THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: That Section 1442.02(a) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read:

- “(a) An application for a certificate of registration required by Section 1442.01 shall be upon a form issued by the ~~Development Director~~/Chief Building Official and Income Tax Division that contains the following information:
- (1) information as required by Section 880.045 of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code of the City;
 - (2) a list of all subcontractors to be utilized, including address and contact information, which list must remain current and updated in writing with the City as necessary;
 - (3) evidence from a proper licensing authority, if applicable, that the applicant has received all necessary licenses;
 - (4) certification that the applicant has not had a license revoked in any state or municipality;
 - (5) certification that the applicant has not been penalized or debarred from any public contract in the previous five (5) years for providing falsified certified payroll records or other violation of the Fair Labor Standards Act;
 - (6) certification that the applicant maintains a substance abuse policy for its personnel per Ohio Governor’s Executive Order No. 2002-13T;
 - (7) certification that the applicant does not have a Bureau of Workers’ Compensation Experience Modification Rating greater than 2.0;
 - (8) certification that the applicant has not had any “serious”, “intentional” or “willful” violations of any Occupational Safety and Health Administration regulations in the previous two (2) years;
 - (9) certification that the applicant has not had any convictions for violations of the Brunswick Building or Zoning Codes within the previous five (5) years;
 - (10) certification that the applicant has not had any performance or indemnification bonds exercised on any projects within the previous ten (10) years;
 - (11) certification that all subcontractors utilized will obtain a certificate of registration from the City prior to being utilized in any project in the City;
 - (12) certification that all individuals being issued an IRS Form 1099 will be considered independent contractors and will obtain a certificate of registration from the City prior to being utilized in any project in the City;
- and

~~(13) Such additional information as the The Development Director/Chief Building Official may also require such additional information as he/she deems advisable. A certificate of registration shall be granted if the application fully conforms with Section 880.045 of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code the requirements of this Section and the Development Director/Chief Building Official finds that the applicant is qualified to perform the work for which the application is sought.~~

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
