

PUBLIC HEARING

BRUNSWICK CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

A text amendment is proposed to Section 1270.10 of the City of Brunswick Codified Ordinances by removing streamers as a permitted temporary sign. Section 1270.10(a)(2)(A) shall now read as follows: “Notwithstanding the signs prohibited by Section 1270.11, the following types of signs are permitted as temporary signs:

A. Pennants or banners.”

Additionally, a text amendment is proposed to Section 1270.11 to create subsection (n) “Streamers” as a prohibited sign.

The Brunswick City Planning Commission will hold a public hearing for this proposal on Thursday, January 18, 2018, beginning at 7:30 p.m. The hearing will be held in Council Chambers at the Brunswick Municipal Center, 4095 Center Road. The application can be reviewed in the office of Community Development during normal business hours, or by appointment.
