

APPLICATION FOR STUDENT EXEMPTION

Persuant to Section 880.04(e) 12 of the Brunswick Codified Code, you may wish to claim exemption for earnings as a student dependent living outside Brunswick while attending college. To claim this exemption, the following provisions must be met:

1. Student must provide copy of student ID card and proof of enrollment at college or university.
2. Student must provide copy of first page of Federal Return (front & back) showing they did not take exemption for themself.
3. If student has no Federal Return, but still has earnings, must provide their parent's Social Security Number so tax office can cross-reference to see the parents of said student have claimed student as dependent. (In this case, Parents are required to attach first page of the Federal Return (front & back) to their Brunswick City Tax return and file by due date.)
4. Student must provide proof of residency outside City of Brunswick while attending college or university.
5. Student must provide proof of residency outside City of Brunswick while earning any and all compensation.

NOTE: Compliance with either numbers 1, 2, 4 & 5 above or compliance with 1, 3, 4 & 5 above must be met for the exemption to be validly claimed under 880.04(e) 12.
