1. This Application and Release Form must be completed and submitted to the City at least five (5) days prior to the date of the proposed Block Party and/or requested street closure or a permit may not be granted.
2. Subject to the requirements of Codified Ordinance Section 412.02, the City Manager, in his/her sole discretion, shall determine whether to grant the requested permit, grant a modified permit or to deny such permit, and shall determine the hours of operation of the Block Party and/or street closure.
3. Insurance. The Applicant shall provide the City with proof of liability insurance in an aggregate amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) at least five (5) days prior to the date of the proposed Block Party and/or street closure or the City Manager shall refuse to issue a permit. The City Manager, in his/her sole discretion, may waive the insurance requirement contained herein for good cause shown.
4. A permit will not be granted unless 75% of the residents on that portion of the street requested for closure sign this Application and Release Form.

**Regulations:**

Please note the following partial, non-exclusive list of applicable laws contained in the City of Brunswick Codified Ordinances that may relate to Block Parties:

**Fireworks - 672.09(f)**

- (1) No person shall possess fireworks in this Municipality or shall possess for sale or sell fireworks in this Municipality...
- (2) ...no person shall discharge, ignite, or explode any fireworks in this Municipality.

**Disorderly conduct - 648.04(a)** No person shall recklessly cause inconvenience annoyance or alarm to another by doing any of the following:

- (1) Engaging in fighting, in threatening harm to persons or property, or in violent or turbulent behavior;
- (2) Making unreasonable noise or offensively course utterance, gesture or display, or communicating unwarranted and grossly abusive language to any person;
- (3) Insulting, taunting or challenging another under circumstances in which that conduct is likely to provoke a violent response;

**Disorderly conduct - 648.04(b)** No person, while voluntarily intoxicated shall do either of the following:

- (1) In a public place or in the presence of two or more persons, engage in conduct likely to be offensive or to cause inconvenience, annoyance or alarm to persons of ordinary sensibilities, which conduct the offender, if he were not intoxicated, should know is likely to have such effect on others;
- (2) Engage in conduct or create a condition which presents a risk of physical harm to himself or another, or to the property of another.

**Underage consumption of alcohol – 612.04(e)** No underage person shall knowingly order, pay for, share the cost of, attempt to purchase, possess, or consume any beer or intoxicating liquor, in any public or private place.

**Noise violation - 634.04(i)** Operating, playing or permitting the operation or playing of any radio, television, phonograph, drum, musical instrument, sound amplifier or similar device which produces, reproduces or amplifies sound:

- (1) Between the hours of 9:00 p.m. (Sunday - Thursday) and 8:00 a.m., the following day and midnight (Friday and Saturday) and 8:00 a.m., the following day in such a manner as to create a noise disturbance across a residential real property boundary,

**Overnight parking on street prohibited 452.16** All night parking shall be restricted upon all City streets, and no person shall permit to stand or be parked any vehicle between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., except through the express consent of the Chief of Police or his designee. **Release:** THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREE TO ASSUME ALL RISK OF INJURIES TO PROPERTY OR PERSONS OR DEATH RESULTING FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE BLOCK PARTY. THE UNDERSIGNED FURTHER AGREES THAT THEY WILL INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD THE CITY, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES HARMLESS FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS OR DEMANDS OF ANY KIND OR DESCRIPTION WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, COSTS AND REASONABLE ATTORNEY FEES, ARISING FROM THE PROPOSED BLOCK PARTY.

I, the undersigned, hereby request or otherwise do not object to the granting of a Block Party permit, and by my signature I am indicating my understanding of the regulations set forth herein. Further, by my signature, I am indicating my understanding and voluntary agreement to the Indemnification and Release of the City of Brunswick from any liability associated with this event.
